This Notice of Hearing is prepared pursuant to the requirements established by A.R.S. § 32-1928 and A.C.R.R. R4-23-104.

JURISDICTION

I

For the reasons stated herein, and pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1928 the Board of Pharmacy will conduct a hearing at 1:30 p.m., the 24th day of January, 1984, at the Tucson Community Center, 260 S. Church St. Tucson, Arizona to determine whether or not Certificate of Registration No. 4888 issued to Edward Michael Zuchowski should be revoked, suspended, or placed on probation.

PARTIES

II

The Arizona State Board of Pharmacy is that body created and empowered pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1904 to administer the laws of the State of Arizona relating to the practice of pharmacy.

III

Edward Michael Zuchowski is the holder of Certificate of Registration No. 4888, which allows him to engage in the practice of

Pharmacy in the State of Arizona.

CHARGES

IV

- A. On or about May 16, 1983, Edward Michael Zuchowski was convicted of the crime of murder, a felony, in the 180th District Court of Harris County, Houston, Texas, in Cause #334006.
- B. On or about August 17, 1983, the Texas State Board of Pharmacy revoked pharmacist license No. 25462 held by Edward Michael Zuchowski. Said license has not been reinstated.

CAUSE OF ACTION

V

Arizona Revised Statutes § 32-1927.A provides that the Certificate of Registration of any pharmacist may be revoked, suspended or placed on probation by the Board when:

2. The registrant has been convicted of a felony.
10. The registrant is found by the board to have had his license to practice pharmacy denied, suspended or revoked in another jurisdiction and the license was not reinstated.

NOTICE OF HEARING

VI

Edward Michael Zuchowski is directed to mail to the Board no later than the 15th day of January, 1984, a written response to the charges described above, specifically his defenses, assertions, or comments concerning such charges.

Edward Michael Zuchowski is notified that he may appear, with or without the assistance of an attorney, on the date and at the time and place specified in this Notice of Hearing and present testimony and

argument in support of his defense with respect to the assertions contained in this Notice of Hearing.

If the respondent fails to appear, the Board may proceed and determine the matter in his absence.

Edward Michael Zukowski is further notified that no continuance will be granted unless a request for continuance is submitted to the Board in writing, detailing the reasons for the requested continuance, and that request is granted by the Board. Except in the event of an emergency, a request for continuance shall be submitted to the Board no later than seven (7) days prior to the date of hearing.
