This matter came before the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy for hearing on the 8th day of October, 1985, pursuant to Complaint and Notice of hearing No. 85-5-H (hereinafter referred to as "Complaint"), attached to and made a part of this order. Bettina Lopez, president, presided, with Al Brooks, vice president, and members Susan Boswell, Simon Eisenberg, Adaline Pangrazi, and Joe Rowan in attendance and participating therein.

The State was represented by the office of the Attorney General, Montgomery Lee, Assistant Attorney General. The respondent, Barbara E. Cox, was not represented by legal counsel.

The Board, after consideration of the evidence and testimony presented, hereby makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

I

Barbara E. Cox is a pharmacist holding Certificate of Registration No. 7796 issued by the Board under A.R.S. § 32-1922.

II

Sufficient evidence was presented, including Barbara E. Cox's admission, to substantiate the charges contained in paragraph IV of the complaint.

3 That the Findings of Fact set forth herein above constitute sufficient
4 evidence to find that Barbara E. Cox is in violation of those state and
5 federal laws, rules and regulations contained in paragraph IV of the
6 complaint.

8 The above described violations constitute grounds for discipline
9 pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1927.

12 In view of the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law the Board
13 hereby issues the following Order:

- 14 1. That the Certificate of Registration No. 7796 issued to Barbara E.
15 Cox be suspended for a period of three (3) years, effective October 9, 1985,
16 terminating October 8, 1988.
- 17 2. That the suspension of Certificate of Registration No. 7796 issued
18 to Barbara E. Cox be stayed.
- 19 3. That the Certificate of Registration No. 7796 issued to Barbara E. Cox
20 be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years, effective October 9,
21 1985, terminating October 8, 1988.
- 22 4. That Barbara E. Cox provide the Board with quarterly reports from the
23 After Care Program Director. Any questionable report may be cause for recon-
24 sideration of these sanctions.
- 25 5. If at any time during the three (3) year period that the suspension
26 is stayed, Barbara E. Cox is found after a hearing to be in violation of any

1 federal or state law, rule or regulation promulgated pursuant thereto,
2 regarding the practice of pharmacy and/or the dispensing of drugs, or is found
3 guilty of drug or alcohol abuse, or any other condition imposed by this order,
4 the stay of suspension may terminate and the Certificate of Registration No.
5 7796 may be revoked upon motion carried by the majority of the Board.

6 Barbara E. Cox is hereby notified she has the right to petition this
7 Board for a rehearing within ten (10) days after receipt of this Order
8 pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Rule R4-23-109.
