The Arizona State Board of Pharmacy and John Dexter Friedl stipulate to the entry of this Consent Order to resolve the charges set forth in the Notice of Hearing in this matter dated May 13, 1988. The entry of this Consent Order is specifically designed to protect the public health, safety and welfare.

FINDINGS OF FACT

John Dexter Friedl, without admitting or denying any of the findings set forth herein, stipulates that based on the evidence in the possession of the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy inspectors, the Board of Pharmacy could make the following findings of fact:

1. John Dexter Friedl is the holder of the Certificate of Registration No. 7111 which allows him to engage in the practice of pharmacy in the state of Arizona.

2. John Dexter Friedl was the Responsible Pharmacist (as defined in A.R.S. § 32-1901.55) of Town and Country Pharmacy, 931 North Swan Road, Tucson, Arizona, between the months of January 1987 and March 1988.

1 months to be effective from June 21, 1988 to June 20, 1991, with
2 no probation to follow.

3 2. The above-imposed suspension of Certificate of
4 Registration No. 7111 issued to John Dexter Friedl is stayed,
5 provided that the following conditions are satisfied:

6 A. John Dexter Friedl shall institute appropriate
7 policies and procedures to ensure that no future
8 dealings of the kind involved in this case shall occur
9 at Town and Country Pharmacy.

10 B. A written report shall be presented by John
11 Dexter Friedl to the Board of Pharmacy detailing the
12 steps taken to implement the aforesaid policies and
13 procedures. The report shall be submitted no later
14 than September 21, 1988.

15 C. John Dexter Friedl shall take the
16 jurisprudence examination, and pass with a score of
17 seventy-five (75) or better, within sixty (60) days of
18 the entry of this Order.

19 3. John Dexter Friedl shall pay a civil fine of
20 \$500.00.

21 4. During the period of the stayed suspension, John
22 Dexter Friedl will be a law abiding citizen and pharmacist and
23 will not violate any Arizona or federal law, rule or regulation
24 relating to the manufacture or distribution of drugs and devices,
25 or the practice of pharmacy. Any violation of the terms of his
26 stayed suspension will result in a hearing before the Board after

1 thirty (30) days' notice. After such hearing, the Board may
2 reinstate the balance of the thirty-six-month suspension or any
3 additional disciplinary penalties supported by the evidence
4 presented at such hearing.

5 This Consent Order is agreed to and accepted by the
6 undersigned parties or their duly authorized representatives.
