Pursuant to the foregoing Consent to Entry of Order, the evidence and records compiled and contained in the file for ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY and for good cause appearing, the Board on this 22nd day of September, 1994 enters the following Finding of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Board Order in the matter of 94-03-H.

FINDINGS OF FACT

I

1. ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY is the holder of Certificate of Registration Number 7976 issued by the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy which permits the holder to engage in the practice of pharmacy in the State of Arizona.

2. That on the 10th day of August, 1994 ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY did enter into a Consent to Entry of Order with the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy admitting that factual allegations contained in the Notice of Hearing Number 94-03-H are true and accurate.

3. That ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY admits to violations of Ohio Revised Code pertaining to marijuana, prescription-only drugs, narcotics, dangerous drugs or controlled substances.

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3 4. That ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY is aware of the fact that the
4 conduct contained in the factual allegations constitutes grounds
5 for disciplinary action as provided for in A.R.S. § 32-1927 (A) (2)
6 and A.R.S. § 32-1927 (B) (2).

7 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

9 1. The Board concludes that it has jurisdiction in this matter
10 pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1927 (A) (2) and 32-1927 (B) (2).

11 2. The Board concludes that ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY did violate
12 Ohio Revised Code pertaining to marijuana, prescription-only drugs,
13 narcotics, dangerous drugs or controlled substances.

14 3. The Board further concludes that ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY is in
15 violation of A.R.S. § 32-1927 (A) (2) and 32-1927 (B) (2).

16 ORDER

18 The certificate of Registration Number 7976 issued to ROLLAND
19 GENE ECKLEY is hereby suspended until February 9, 1995, effective
20 10 days from the date of this Order.

21 On or after the 9th day of February 1995, ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY
22 may appear before the Board of Pharmacy to show cause why the
23 suspension should be stayed and a probation imposed. Said probation
24 would continue, at minimum, until the 9th day of February, 2000
25 subject to the following conditions:
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1. ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY shall not serve as a preceptor pharmacist nor as a Pharmacist in Charge throughout the term of probation.

2. ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY shall take and successfully complete the Arizona Jurisprudence Examination (AZPLEX) with a score of 90% or better prior to appearing before the Board to request removal of suspension of Certificate of Registration Number 7976.

3. ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY shall furnish the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy with a list of all jurisdictions in which he maintains or has maintained licensure in the profession of pharmacy along with the registration number of said licenses.

4. ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY is required to advise the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy immediately of any change in pharmacy employment status throughout the term of probation.

5. ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY is required to furnish any and all pharmacy employers with a copy of this Board Order throughout the term of probation.

6. ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY shall pay all fees and complete all Continuing Education requirements to maintain certificate of registration number 7976 throughout the term of probation.

7. ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY shall obey all federal and state laws and rules governing the practice of pharmacy.

8. ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY shall bear the responsibility for the release of information forms and reports required by this Order.

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9. ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY shall "hold harmless" the provider of any reports to the Board of Pharmacy.

10. ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY shall appear before the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy on or after the 9th day of February, 2000 to show cause why the probation imposed in this matter should be removed.

11. If ROLLAND GENE ECKLEY violates this Order in any way or fails to fulfill the requirements of this Order, the Board, after giving the Respondent Notice and the opportunity to be heard, may revoke, suspend or take other disciplinary action against the Respondent.
