9 Pursuant to the foregoing Consent to Entry of Order, the evidence
10 and records compiled and contained in the file for JANET L. SAFRANSKE
11 and for good cause appearing, the Board on this 12th day of March,
12 1998 enters the following Finding of Fact, Conclusions of Law and
13 Board Order in the Matter of 98-0006-PHR.

14 FINDINGS OF FACT

15 I

16 1. JANET L. SAFRANSKE is the holder of Certificate of
17 Registration Number 11201 issued by the Arizona State Board of
18 Pharmacy which permits the holder to practice pharmacy in the State of
19 Arizona.

20 2. That on the 13th day of March, 1998, JANET L. SAFRANSKE did
21 enter into a Consent to Entry of Order with the Arizona State Board of
22 Pharmacy admitting that factual allegations contained in the Notice of
23 Hearing Number 98-0006-PHR are true and accurate.

24 3. That JANET L. SAFRANSKE admits to violations of A.R.S. § 32-
25 1927(A)(10), A.R.S. § 32-1927(B)(1) and A.A.C. § R4-23-402 (B) to wit:

1 32-1927(A)(10) The licensee is found by the Board to be guilty of
2 violating any Arizona or federal law, rule or regulation relating to
3 the manufacture and distribution of drugs, and devices or the practice
4 of pharmacy.

5 32-1927 (B)(1)The licensee is found by the Board to be guilty of
6 dispensing a different drug or brand of drug ordered or prescribed
7 without the express permission in each case of the orderer, or in the
8 case of a prescription order, the medical practitioner. The conduct
9 prohibited by this paragraph does not apply to substitutions
10 authorized pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1963.01.

11 A.A.C. § R4-23-402 (B) The following professional practices in
12 directly dispensing a prescription medication from a prescription
13 order shall be performed by a pharmacist or a pharmacy intern under
14 the supervision of a pharmacist:

15 (B) The pharmacist or pharmacy intern shall personally provide
16 oral communication, which shall include directions for use, name
17 of prescribed medication, and any special instructions,
18 precautions or storage requirements, to the patient or the
19 patient's agent in all outpatient settings.....

20 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

21 II

22 1. The Board concludes that it has jurisdiction in this Matter
23 pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1927(A)(10) and A.R.S. § 32-1927(B)(2).

24 2. The Board concludes that JANET L. SAFRANSKE did violate A.R.S.
25 § 32-1927(A)(10), A.R.S. § 32-1927(B)(1) and A.A.C. § R4-23-402 (B).

26 ORDER

III

The certificate of Registration Number 11201 issued to JANET L.
SAFRANSKE is hereby placed on probation for up to (1) year commencing
ten (10) days from the date of this Order. The probation is subject to
the following conditions:

1 1. JANET L. SAFRANSKE shall complete eight (8) hours of
2 Continuing Education within one year of the date of this Order. Said
3 hours shall consist of the two part series (4 hours each) titled
4 Pharmacist-Patient Consultation Program or an alternative program
5 approved by the Board and shall apply only to satisfy this Order and
6 shall not be applied to Continuing Education requirements for
7 subsequent license renewals.

8 2. JANET L. SAFRANSKE shall pay all fees and complete all
9 Continuing Education requirements throughout the term of probation to
10 maintain Certificate of Registration Number 11201.

11 3. JANET L. SAFRANSKE shall obey all federal and state laws and
12 rules governing the practice of pharmacy.

13 4. The Arizona State Board of Pharmacy shall terminate the
14 probation upon completion of the condition outlined in paragraph 1.
15 above.

16 5. If JANET L. SAFRANSKE violates this Order in any way or fails
17 to fulfill the requirements of this Order, the Board, after giving the
18 Respondent Notice and the opportunity to be heard, may revoke, suspend
19 or take other disciplinary action against the Respondent.
