10 Pursuant to the foregoing Consent to Entry of Order, the evidence
 11 and records compiled and contained in the file for JEFFREY K. KARP and
 12 for good cause appearing, the Board on this 9th day of July, 1998
 13 enters the following Finding of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Board
 14 Order in the Matter of 98-0018-PHR.

14 FINDINGS OF FACT

15 I

16 1. JEFFREY K. KARP is the holder of Certificate of Registration
 17 Number 11009 issued by the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy which
 18 permits the holder to engage in the profession of pharmacy in the
 19 State of Arizona.

20 2. That the evidence and testimony presented in this Matter did
 21 sustain the allegations in Paragraphs IV of the Notice, to wit:

22 JEFFREY K. KARP was a participant in the Pharmacists Assisting
 23 Pharmacists of Arizona (PAPA) program established pursuant to A.R.S.
 24 § 32-1932.01 between the dates of May 1, 1997 and March 30, 1998. On
 25 or about March 30, 1998, JEFFREY K. KARP did submit a bodily fluid
 26 drug screen as required by his PAPA contract which was positive for

1 morphine, a Controlled Substance as listed in the Notice of Hearing.
2 JEFFREY K. KARP has no known medical condition that requires treatment
3 with the Controlled Substance listed in the Notice and no
4 prescriptions were produced to demonstrate that the Controlled
5 Substance was obtained pursuant to a prescription from a licensed
6 medical practitioner.

7 The conduct contained in the factual allegations constitutes
8 grounds for disciplinary action as provided for in A.R.S. § 32-
9 1927(A)(5) & (10) and A.R.S. § 32-1927(B)(2).

10 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

11 II

12 1. The Board concludes that it has jurisdiction in this Matter
13 pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-1927 (A)(5) & (10) and A.R.S. §32-1927(B)(2).

14 2. The conduct alleged and sustained in Paragraphs IV of the
15 Notice constitutes violations of A.R.S. § 32-1927(A)(5) & (10) and
16 A.R.S. § 32-1927(B)(2).

17 ORDER

18 III

19 The Certificate of Registration Number 11009 issued to JEFFREY K.
20 KARP is hereby suspended for a period of five years effective 10 days
21 from the date of this Order. On or after September 16th, 1998 JEFFREY
22 K. KARP may appear before the Arizona State Board of Pharmacy, then
23 and there to show cause why the suspension should be stayed and a
24 probation be imposed for a period of time commencing at the time the
25 suspension is stayed and continuing to at least July 9th, 2003.

26 . . .

1 Further, if granted, said probation would be subject to the following
2 conditions:

3 1. JEFFREY K. KARP shall not serve as a preceptor pharmacist nor
4 as a pharmacist in charge throughout the term of probation.

5 2. JEFFREY K. KARP shall take and successfully complete the
6 Arizona Jurisprudence Examination (AZPLEX) with a score of 90% or
7 better within 120 days of the date of this order.

8 3. JEFFREY K. KARP shall complete four hundred (400) hours of
9 Board approved community service, documentation to be submitted upon
10 completion, prior to termination of probation.

11 4. JEFFREY K. KARP shall furnish the Arizona State Board of
12 Pharmacy with a list of all jurisdictions in which he maintains or has
13 maintained licensure in the profession of pharmacy along with the
14 registration number of said licenses.

15 5. JEFFREY K. KARP is required to advise the Arizona State
16 Board of Pharmacy immediately of any change in pharmacy employment
17 status throughout the term of probation.

18 6. JEFFREY K. KARP is required to furnish any and all pharmacy
19 employers with a copy of this Board Order throughout the term of
20 probation.

21 7. JEFFREY K. KARP shall pay all fees and complete all
22 Continuing Education requirements to maintain certificate of
23 registration number 11009 throughout the term of probation.

24 8. JEFFREY K. KARP shall obey all federal and state laws and
25 rules governing the practice of pharmacy.

26 9. JEFFREY K. KARP shall bear the responsibility for the

1 release of information forms and reports required by this Order.

2 10. JEFFREY K. KARP shall sign and be in compliance with a new
3 five year contract with the Pharmacists Assisting Pharmacists of
4 Arizona (PAPA) and comply with each and every requirement of that
5 contract.

6 11. JEFFREY K. KARP shall submit to a minimum of twenty-four
7 (24) annual random biological fluid screenings for the presence of
8 drugs in the system as determined by PAPA for the period of suspension
9 and the first twenty-four (24) months of probation. The annual random
10 biological fluid screenings for the presence of drugs in the system
11 shall increase to a minimum of forty-eight (48) when JEFFREY K. KARP
12 accepts employment as a pharmacist and shall continue for the first
13 twenty-four (24) months of probation.

14 12. JEFFREY K. KARP shall "hold harmless" the provider of any
15 required reports to the Board of Pharmacy.

16 13. JEFFREY K. KARP shall appear before the Arizona State Board
17 of Pharmacy on or after July 9th, 2003, then and there to show cause
18 why the probation imposed by this Order should be vacated.

19 14. If JEFFREY K. KARP violates this Order in any way or fails
20 to fulfill the requirements of this Order or the terms of probation,
21 the Board, after giving JEFFREY K. KARP Notice and the opportunity to
22 be heard, may revoke or suspend Board licensure or take other
23 disciplinary action against JEFFREY K. KARP.

21 Pharmacists Assisting Pharmacists of Arizona (PAPA).


22 After deliberation the request by JEFFREY K. KARP was accepted

10 pursuant to a request by the Respondent, to amend the Order in the matter of 98-0018-PHR by removing
11 the prohibition against serving as a pharmacy intern preceptor in an Arizona pharmacy as described in
12 paragraph III, subsection one (1) on page three (3) of the Order. Susan Ford president, presided with vice
13 president Gerald Ritt and members Paul Draugalis, Bill Jones, and Dennis McAllister in attendance and
14 participating therein. The Board heard testimony on the Respondent's compliance with the Pharmacists
15 Assisting Pharmacists of Arizona (PAPA) contract and the Order. After deliberation on the testimony
16 presented, the Board unanimously agreed to amend the Order by removing the prohibition serving as a
17 pharmacy intern preceptor in an Arizona pharmacy as described in paragraph III, subsection one (1) on
18 page three (3). All other conditions as listed in Board Order Number 98-0018-PHR remain intact.
